MARCH BREAKFAST FEATURED BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT BOARD PRESIDENT & CEO

Kelly Smallridge, president and CEO of the Business Development Board of Palm Beach County (BDB), was the guest speaker at the March 3 breakfast at the Palm Beach County Convention Center. The event was sponsored by Florida Atlantic University, which was represented by the university's president, Dr. John W. Kelly. Smallridge spoke about the tremendous achievements made by the BDB in the past year to bring various businesses to Palm Beach County. Some notable observations from her presentation were:

- With roughly 11,000 new residents, Palm Beach County was No. 1 for growth in both people and income.
- Median income had risen to \$62,000 and was the highest in Florida.
- The county's new net income gain of \$3.4 billion was No. 1 in the United States.
