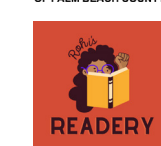

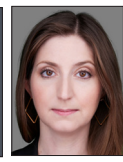
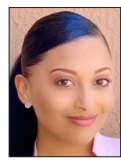

2022 Legislative Update

Bill Herrle, executive director in Florida of the National Federation of Independent Business (NFIB), was guest speaker at the 2022 legislative update breakfast, held at the Palm Beach County Convention Center. In a wide-ranging presentation, Herrle gave a brief overview on the functions of the NFIB and discussed several legislative issues relevant to the business community, including the state budget.

Here are some highlights:

- The state is in an exceptional financial position. Even with the budget at \$112 billion, we were still able to set aside \$1.5 billion in reserves.

- The special session to deal with homeowner's insurance might achieve only limited success.

- The NFIB is asking the Governor to veto SB 1382, which limits the ability of business owners to defend themselves in state tax audits.

- Enacting public policy by way of private causes of action (e.g., the proposed data privacy law and allowing businesses to sue their local governments) was an area of concern.

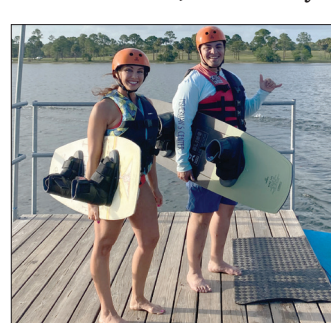
