- Regulation in European Union (EU) law on data protection and privacy for all individual citizens of the European Union
- Effective May 25, 2018
- Emphasis on legal basis and purposes for processing data
- Opt-in
- Right of deletion

"The most important change in data privacy regulation in 20 years."



Data that identifies, relates to, describes, is capable of being associated with, or could be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household

- California Privacy Rights and Enforcement Act (CPRA)
- Effective January 1, 2023
- Opt-out
- California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) remains in effect

Data intelligence will be a patchwork quilt of US data regulation.




