

Last month the City Council approved a slight zoning modification to a site that has been known for years simply as "Site 6." Located adjacent to the historic Downtown square – and across the street from City Hall – it's a significant parcel for the future of the City core.

Now called, "New Square," the Council action allows for the addition of a hotel to the plan that will also include substantial new office and commercial space. The developer is Spike Lawrence Ventures, builders of the popular Downtown Ocotillo complex near Queen Creek and Dobson roads.

This is an exciting project on a number of levels. Chandler office vacancy rates in the downtown area are extremely low, so that type of space is in high demand. It will also create greater pedestrian flow in the area between New Square and the rest of downtown's retail and restaurant scene. The hotel will also be a great addition, boosting tourism revenues and bringing business travelers to the area.

Finally, the City of Chandler has committed to build a large parking garage directly east of the project to recover the lost surface parking New Square will inhabit. This project is literally decades in the making. It involves 23 vacant parcels the City has cobbled together throughout many years of thoughtful planning.

While private sector investment continues to grow downtown, so too does the expansion of higher education opportunities. The City of Chandler and the University of Arizona (UA) recently announced that UA will soon be offering undergraduate courses here. The classes will be held at UA's Chandler location at 125 E. Commonwealth Ave. The university plans to offer four courses at the facility in fall 2018, and another six courses are planned for spring 2019 with start dates in January and March.

Courses include educational credentials in Cybersecurity and other high-demand tech fields that serve the specific needs of the Chandler business community. These courses are also requirements for four UA undergraduate degrees: Bachelor of Applied Science programs in Cyber Operations, Human Services, Informatics, and Network Operations. In addition, the university will offer an undergraduate certificate in Cybersecurity. If your employees work in any of these areas, you may wish to explore the curriculum further.

As the Innovation and Technology Hub of the Southwest, it is critical that our local workforce and residents have access to higher education programs that prepare them for a tech-focused future. Meanwhile, Downtown Chandler continues to become more attractive by the day, whether it be to work, play, live or learn.

Ballot Initiatives

Proposition 125—VOTE “NO”

The Chandler Chamber of Commerce is generally opposed to all Voter Approved ballot initiatives for several reasons.

- They take power away from our elected officials, which makes their job much more difficult.
- There are often unintended or unforeseen consequences to these initiatives as many are written in haste and unprofessionally.
- They are generally proposed by very special interests who seek to serve their own causes and don't represent Arizonans as a whole. As well, many of them come from out of state interests.
- They are essentially final and irreversible, due to the fact the legislature must have a ¾ consensus to change them which is unheard of, particularly in the current extreme partisan environment.
- Due to their finality they do not allow for adaptation or altering which is of paramount importance for conformity to future economic, societal, and political realities.

- It is for these 5 very important reasons that we urge you to vote **NO** on all proposed ballot initiatives, they should not be a substitute for our democratic system of electing leaders to represent our community's best interests.
