While larger companies like Intel, Orbital ATK and Rogers tend to grab headlines when they announce new projects or expansions, I know plenty of small companies are also investing in the community. One great example is Peixoto Coffee Roasters, a downtown favorite that has developed a strong following since it opened in 2015. In fact, they have so many fans they need additional space.

With catering and wholesale business on the rise, they are upping their production capacity with the lease of 8,000 square feet of industrial space in Uptown Chandler near the corner of Arizona Avenue and Elliot Road. This is a tremendous investment for owners Jeff and Julia and I know they will continue to thrive with great coffee and service. Turbo Resources consolidated some work areas in west Chandler and now resides in a new facility under construction in the Westech Corporate Center. With more than a quarter-million-square-foot campus, this aircraft parts distribution company, is set to excel and is a welcomed neighbor in Uptown Chandler.

The Southeast Valley Regional Association of Realtors, or SEVRAR, just opened its new headquarters in Chandler. The building sits on more than three acres in the Chandler Airport area, and will serve the group's 12,000-plus realtors here in the heart of the Southeast Valley.

And finally, in west Chandler, Arizona Nutritional Supplements (ANS) continues to thrive. They expanded into Chandler in 2008 and now are head-quartered here, recently leasing a 100,000-square-foot warehouse. With approximately 600 employees, ANS is another true Chandler success story.

We could fill volumes discussing all the great entrepreneurs who are investing in Chandler. These few examples highlight some of the recent success- es, and they bode well for the future of the entire business community.

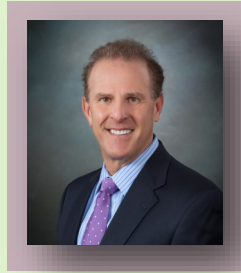





Proposition 408! Vote "Yes" on Prop 408



OFFICIAL TITLE: A resolution proposing a continuation of the local alternative expenditure limitation (Home Rule) for the City of Chandler.

DESCRIPTIVE TITLE: The proposal replaces the state imposed expenditure limitation by continuing the alternative expenditure limitation for Chandler for the next four years. Annually, the City Council will determine the amount of the alternative expenditure limitation for the fiscal year after at least one public hearing. Established exclusions shall continue to apply.

A "YES" vote shall have the effect of continuing the local alternative expenditure limitation (Home Rule) for the City of Chandler.

A "NO" vote shall have the effect of not allowing the City of Chandler to continue a local alternative expenditure limitation (Home Rule) and to require expenditures of the City to be limited by the state imposed expenditure formula.

Elections and Voter Registration

On Tuesday, Aug. 28, Chandler residents who are registered voters will have the opportunity to elect a Mayor, three City Councilmembers and consider Proposition 408 (Home Rule Option) during the Primary Election. The deadline to register to vote in the Aug. 28 election is Monday, July 30.

August 28, 2018 Primary Election

The City of Chandler 2018 Primary Election will be held for the purposes of electing a Mayor and three (3) Councilmembers; and for the consideration of Proposition 408 – Alternative Expenditure Limitation (Home Rule Option).
