Autonomous cars, aviation industry creating exciting hubs in Chandler

As Waymo's operational hub for Arizona, Chandler not only embraces this technology research, it is actively planning for its imminent arrival. Just last month, we became the first city in the country to formally adopt zoning code changes to prepare for autonomous vehicles and their impacts on traffic in the city.

The ordinance, unanimously approved by the City Council, does two things. First, it provides our planning staff with the flexibility to reduce minimum parking requirements as the demands for parking change. Secondly, it encourages future developments to install drop-off zones for ride-sharing companies and autonomous vehicles alike. This creates the added benefit to developers to maximize the use of their usable land area.

Chandler continues to be at the forefront of this emerging industry, and this action shows we are all in. We continue to receive national and even global attention for the cluster of companies committed to this technology. They include Intel, General Motors' Innovation Center, NXP Semiconductors, Rogers, Microchip, Maxim Integrated and, of course, Waymo.

Another area that continues to grow in Chandler is the field of aviation. Companies like Aerozone and Turbo Resources are leading parts suppliers, while others like Chandler Air Service, Chandler Aviation, Quantum Helicopters, and Varga Enterprises provide important services and instruction to local aviators who use Chandler Municipal Airport.

A new development called WingSpan also broke ground at the airport last month. WingSpan will provide a new look for Chandler's airport with custom hangars and associated office space and other services. It fills a niche that has been lacking in Chandler, and I look forward to seeing it develop in the coming year.

Finally, congratulations to all the businesses who earned honors at the June 1 Chandler Chamber of Commerce Awards program. It is great to see so many thriving companies in our community.
