# Chandler Mayor Update

Chandler City Council recently had a joint meeting with the Planning and Zoning Commission to talk about the current and future state of development in the community. Input was sought and shared about protecting employment corridors, notification processes, housing makeup and other zoning related topics. At this time, Chandler is about 88% built out so we need to be strategic and calculated when it comes to planning for future development. The remaining 12% of undeveloped land in our community breaks down as follows:

- West Chandler - 10% planned for employment use;
- North Chandler - 20%, planned for 20% residential and 80% employment;
- South Chandler - 70% planned for 11% residential and 85% employment.

With a high percentage of the remaining land planned for employment use, our economic development efforts are focused on attracting companies that offer a diverse array of high wage jobs that advance the economic vitality of our community. In 2018 over 900,000-square-feet of office and industrial space was constructed, with another 1.2 million to be delivered in 2019. The development of speculative office and industrial space is critical as it allows us to be competitive for projects considering expansion or relocation opportunities. We have also welcomed several major job announcements, including Allstate and Voya with plans for 2,500 and 1,060 jobs respectively to the Price Corridor and most recently the retention of Isola Group to the new Lotus Project in the West Chandler employment corridor.

This is an exciting time in Chandler as we are working to decide what the future landscape of our community looks like. To learn more about our economic development efforts, you can visit [chandleraz.gov/ed](http://chandleraz.gov/ed).

## Wrap Up—Friday, August 9th 2019

The Chamber welcomed Dominic Papa of the Arizona Institute for Digital Progress (AZIDP) at our Policy Impact Series meeting. They are an innovation-driven, nonprofit firm that serves all levels of governments, technology-driven companies, innovators, and entrepreneurs. He discussed how his non-profit is trying to work toward getting cities and key industry players to come together and work toward making an Arizona a hub for innovation in the smart city region. They are not only trying to bring all these entities to the table, but give them the tools and knowledge they need to successfully implement such a program.

The Chamber welcomed Jim Bishop and Lana Berry to talk about the upcoming vote for the Chandler Unified School District bond. The district is asking for \$295 million to pay for the construction of new schools as well as the improvement of existing facilities. The money will also go towards upgrading school safety and technology. Chandler Unified School District was recently ranked first in the nation in academic growth, proving that CUSD is a valuable part of our community. These funds will help the district continue to meet and surpass the needs of parents and students.

Mayor Kevin Hartke spoke on the continued vision of our community and outlined the city's goals. Among the goals that Mayor Hartke addressed was the infill and redevelopment of our community, innovation and technology, the city's mobility plans, neighborhood improvement and the improving the overall quality of life.

City Manager, Masha Reed provided the process of the fiscal budget (\$927,046,172) and highlighted the city's revenue and expenditures. Marsha also went into detail about how important it is to maintain aging infrastructure and supporting financially sustainable goals.


### Class 36 Business & Industry Day


