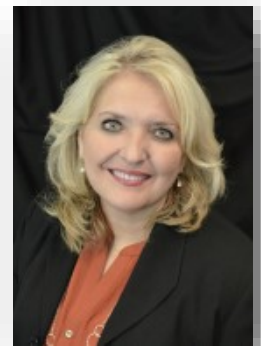

The Chandler Chamber of Commerce started distributing the City of Chandler, I Choose Chandler Free PPE Kits to qualifying Chandler businesses last week. The Chandler City Council authorized the use of \$500,000 of Arizona Cares Act funding for the purchase and distribution of personal protective equipment (PPE) to Chandler businesses in furtherance of protecting the public health during the current emergency.

The Chandler Chamber is distributing these kits because it is a great way to make sure our local businesses have the tools necessary to keep employees and clients within safety guidelines, ensuring a path forward to carry out business as usual. The kits are on a first-come, first-serve basis and will be available until supplies are gone.

To apply for the kit, the business must be registered with the City of Chandler, have 100 employees or less, and you will have to meet the qualifications. Certain organizations are exempt. Fill out the online application at www.chandlerchamber.com.

These are nice kits with a standing hand sanitizer, a gallon of refill sanitizer and 100 disposable masks. Please take advantage of these kits as they will be available until distribution is finished.



See if your business qualifies for a free I Choose Chandler PPE Kit

The Chandler Chamber of Commerce, via a contract with the City of Chandler, is distributing I Choose Chandler PPE (personal protective equipment) Kits to Chandler businesses who qualify for the program, launching mid-October.

The Chandler City Council authorized the use of \$500,000 of Arizona Cares Act funding for the purchase and distribution of personal protective equipment (PPE) to Chandler businesses in furtherance of protecting the public health during the current emergency “Protecting public health has been Council’s top priority throughout the pandemic,” said Chandler Mayor Kevin Hartke. “The I Choose Chandler PPE Kit Program is another way the City continues to create innovative programs to keep employees and patrons safe, while providing much needed assistance to our business community.”

The PPE Kit consists of the following:

- Two (2) boxes of 50 each 3-Ply Non-Medical Face Mask with Ear-Loop
- One (1) automatic hand sanitizer dispenser with Stand
- One (1) hand Sanitizer, 1 Gallon

Chandler businesses must meet the following criteria to be eligible for a PPE Kit:

- Be a registered business with the City of Chandler
- Business must be located in the municipal boundary of the City of Chandler
- Have 100 or less employees
- The following are excluded from qualifying: Non-Profits, home based businesses, vacation rentals, rentals of commercial property, internet based businesses, kiosks or vending businesses, car service provider (i.e. Uber, Lyft, other taxi service)

Since August, the City of Chandler has allocated over \$10 million to support Chandler-based businesses impacted by COVID-19. More than \$3 million has already been awarded to businesses in our community, and we still have more dollars to distribute! We appreciate the feedback we have received from those who have participated in our business assistance programs. Please know that we are listening and are committed to delivering programs that meet local business needs.

Below is a breakdown of the three business assistance programs the City of Chandler is currently offering:

Choose Chandler Grants

Overview: This reimbursement grant program assists small businesses with costs incurred from purchasing personal protective equipment (PPE). This will help ensure that businesses can offer a safe environment for their employees and their customers.

Funding Available to Each Applicant: \$100 to \$500 for reimbursable PPE purchases that were procured after March 11, 2020.

Total Funding Allocated to Program: \$200,000 from the Chandler Industrial Development Authority

Businesses Supported to Date: More than 200

Qualifications and How to Apply: chandleraz.gov/ChooseChandlerGrants

I Choose Chandler Business Hiring and Retention Program | AZCares

Overview: This program is intended to support Chandler businesses that are keeping workers on payroll as they adjust to revenue losses and business disruptions caused by COVID-19.

Funding Available to Each Applicant: Qualifying businesses can apply to receive \$1,300 per full-time equivalent employee retained or hired since Dec. 31, 2019. Businesses can also apply for relief funding if they have paid at least \$40,000 in compensation to 1099-eligible independent contractors this year. The maximum total program award is \$10,000. Funding provided will not need to be repaid.

Total Funding Allocated to Program: \$9.5 million from AZCares funding

Businesses Supported to Date: More than 450

Qualifications and How to Apply: Now open to all industries and businesses that utilize independent contractors. Visit azfoundation.org/ICC to apply for funding based on employee retention/hiring. Visit chandleraz.gov/icc to apply for funding based on utilization of 1099-eligible independent contractors.

Business Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Program | AZCares

Overview: The City has contracted the Chandler Chamber to distribute free Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) kits to Chandler businesses in furtherance of protecting public health during the pandemic.

Funding Available to Each Applicant: Kit includes two boxes of 50 non-medical surgical masks, one automatic hand sanitizer standing dispenser and one gallon of hand sanitizer – a \$240 value.

Total Program Funding: \$500,000 from AZCares funding

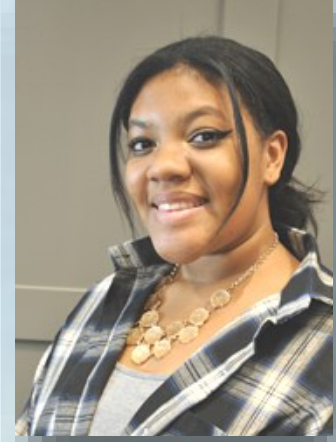
New Faces at the Chandler Chamber

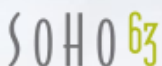

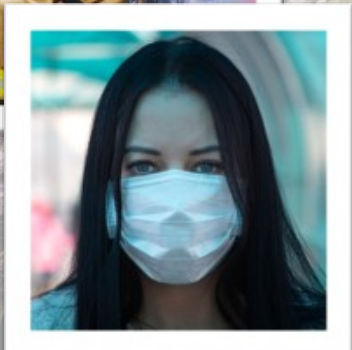
