Departing board members, the year's achievements, and partnerships were highlighted at the gathering, and award winners were recognized for their accomplishments.

The following were honored during the awards ceremony:



Gene Sieve of Burns & McDonnell Consultants-Engineers was honored with this year's Tom Roche Lifetime Achievement Award. This award is presented to an individual who has contributed significantly during their career to the engineering profession, ACEC/MN, and the greater community. Gene has had a long-standing commitment to ACEC, where he has served in several capacities, including President and National Director of the ACEC/MN Board of Directors, various committees and events over the years, and active participation in the ACEC/PAC, both locally and nationally. Congratulations to Gene, who has become a trusted resource to the association and engineering community.

The **2018** Firm of the Year Award was presented to **BKBM** Engineers. This award is presented to an ACEC/MN member firm that has made a significant contribution to the advancement of the association and the consulting engineering profession. BKBM Engineers has been an incredible supporter of the association by serving at the board and committee chair level, contributing to the scholarship fund, and participating in events. Three principals of this firm have served as ACEC/MN President and three



employees over the years have been scholarship recipients. BKBM employees have made significant contributions to the profession, including the development of

Minnesota's Special Inspections Guidelines, and developing presentations for Engineers Week and the Explorer Post program, which reached over 800 students last year.

This year's <u>President's Award</u> was presented to **Kim Deibel** of **American Engineering Testing, Inc.** This award is presented to an individual employed by a member firm that has been an asset to the association and consulting engineering profession over the past year. Kim is a dedicated, active leader who has a passion

for mentoring students and future engineers. She has served on multiple committees and chaired the Minnesota Structural Engineers Association (MNSEA). In 2018, Kim helped coordinate a relationship between ACEC/MN and STEMLink, which has resulted in presentations that are reaching approximately 250 kids annually.

The Emerging Leader Award was presented to Eric McElrath of Mattson Macdonald Young, Inc. This award was created to recognize an ACEC member still in the early stages of their career who has already contributed significantly to the association. Eric is a past Bob Rosene scholarship recipient of ACEC/MN and has been giving back to the profession ever since. Eric participates in ACEC/MN events and was a founding member and chair of the Minnesota Structural Engineers Association (MNSEA) Young Member Group. During Eric's year as president, he received a scholarship from the National Council of Structural Engineers (NCSE) and the Young Member Group of the Year Award on behalf of the committee.





The **2018** <u>Distinguished Service Award</u> was presented to **Brad Hamilton** of **MnDOT**. This award was designed to honor an individual who has given countless volunteer hours of support to the association and engineering profession. Brad has worked successfully to enhance the relationship between MnDOT and consulting engineers since the creation of his position in 2010. He has fostered a cooperative culture through working teams, process improvement, training, workshops, open houses, and one-on-one collaboration.

Outgoing president **Tim Korby** of **Donohue & Associates**, **Inc.** was also honored at the event for his leadership over the past year. Incoming President **Dan Larson** of **American Engineering Testing**, **Inc.** presented Tim with an honorary gavel in recognition of his service to the association.
