
## February Flakes





MAC owns and operates seven airports in the Metropolitan Area. Each has its own role and fleet mix.
















#### Metropolitan Council **Airport Classification**





- MAC created by the Legislature in 1943
- We are an Airport Authority that owns and operates seven airports
- 15 Member Policy Board
- 600-person staff
- MSP operates much like a city, with its own:
  - $\circ$  Police
  - o Fire
  - 9-1-1 dispatch
  - Building inspection
  - Planning
  - Maintenance Department


## Major Projects and Improvements



MSP is likely to serve more than 50 million passengers annually by 2035.


To meet demand, the MAC is investing more than \$1.6 billion in airport improvements over the next several years – and \$2.5 billion by 2035.






#### Terminal 1 Operational Improvements Program.








### Improved Flow Between Levels of Terminal 1

Elevators and escalators linearly aligned to provide more efficient movement

Centrally located services: food, retail, information desks and restrooms




### **MSP InterContinental Hotel**

Construction of the new ramp with improved auto rental and transit facilities is on schedule for 2020 completion.






