

#### DELIVERY METHODS FOR PROEJCT EXECUTION

# Design/Bid/Build

- Most Common delivery method
- Bidding documents posted on-line
- Bids received on-line
- Lowest responsible contractor selected

# **Construction Manager at Risk**

- Typical delivery method for large complex projects
- CM selection is based on scored criteria and fee
- CM participates in design phase
- Guaranteed Maximum Price is established prior to bidding
- Lowest prequalified subcontractor is selected

# **Invited Request**

#### **SOLICITATION**

- RFP invited by Campus Project Manager
- Threshold: Under \$50K

#### **PROJECT TYPES**

- Typically simple projects funded with campus funds
- Construction often occurs during summer
- Small asset preservation

# **Facilities P/T Master Contract**

#### PROGRAM SOLICITATION FOR MASTER CONTRACT

- Based on qualifications for 34 services
- RFQ announced in State Register for annual submission
   Next occurrence Jan/Feb 2020





# **Facilities PT Master Contract**

### **PROJECT SOLICITATION FOR PO** (against Master Contract)

- Requested by Campus Project Manager
- Threshold: Under \$100K

#### **PROJECT TYPES**

- Typically simple projects funded with campus or HEAPR funds
- Construction often occurs during summer

#### **SOLICITATION**

- RFP announced in State Register
