The Small Business Job Creation Tax Credit Act will support small businesses and local communities. This legislation will make a **\$2,500.00 tax credit** available to small businesses that hire a net new employee.

To qualify for the tax credit, a small business must:



Have 50 or fewer full-time employees

Months

Hire a net employee and maintain that higher rate of employment over a 12month period

35 HOURS/WEEK

Hire an employee that works at least 35 hours /week
