Skokie's Spring Greening began in 2011 as a community fair for residents to promote sustainable and green living. Since then, participation has grown, with over 950 vehicles dropping off household items as they visit specialty station after station. Over the years this event has evolved into a comprehensive, community recycling event open to all households of Niles Township and those residing in communities of the Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County (SWANCC). Skokie's Festival of Cultures is held on Skokie's 19-acre Oakton Park. It has grown over nearly three decades from 14 cultures with 1,000 attendees, to more than three dozen cultures and 25,000 visitors, annually. Over two days in May, visitors enjoy ethnic folk music and dance on two stages, arts and crafts, international children's games, food, cultural booths, a merchandise bazaar, a mini train ride around the park, and the festival's iconic flag display. The festival has been honored with both state and national art event programming awards

18th Backlot Bash (3-Day Outdoor Festival & Block Party)

Having quickly earned a reputation for quality, original live music, as well as a host of unique carnival rides and family attractions — Skokie's downtown summer street festival is held annually over three days in late August, one week prior to Labor Day weekend. Since its inception in 2007, Skokie's Backlot Bash has presented international eclectic Rock, Blues and R&B artists, including The Psychedelic Furs, Presidents of the United States of America, Living Colour, War, Kid 'n Play, Cracker, The Smithereens, Marshall Crenshaw, Spin Doctors, Blue Oyster Cult, Smoking Popes, and many more!

The festival has expanded to include a court of food vendors, other business merchants, a 5K run, and classic car show.
