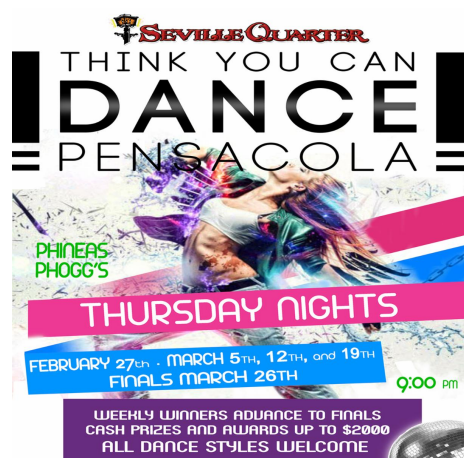

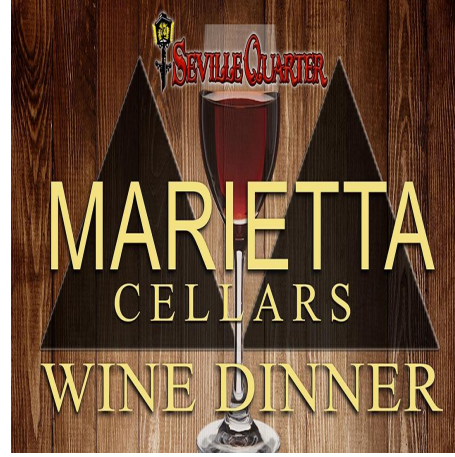

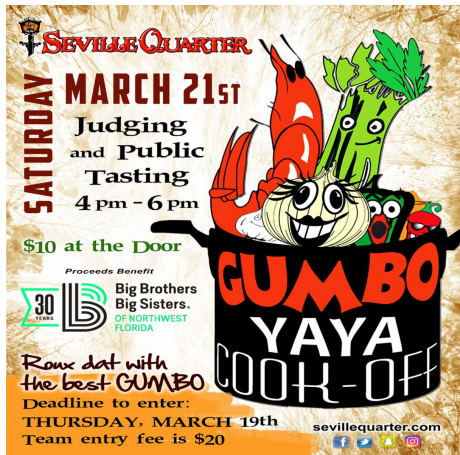

## Wine with Caroline!

Hello again to Wine with Caroline!

For those who are first-time readers, my name is Caroline Belle Chilton and I'm the Wine & Gift Shoppe Manager. I'm passionate about wine and will be sharing my two favorites each month. Let's get started with my picks for March!

The first wine I'm recommending is the 2018 Russian River Chardonnay by the Hartford Family Winery. This refined Chardonnay starts off with a bouquet of jasmine blossoms and pears, beautifully citrusy. The initial palate is reminiscent of tropical kiwi and then mellows into butter-baked apples. The mouthfeel is a wonderful balance of creaminess and brightness. I would personally pair this wine with Cajun food such as spiced crawfish, gumbo, and crab cakes. It runs for \$20.99 in the Wine Shoppe!

The second wine is the 2016 Marietta Armé. It is majorly Cabernet Sauvignon and has touches of Merlot, Malbec, and Petit Verdot. This bold wine begins with dense savory notes of sage and anise, then broadens out with sumptuous dark forest fruits on the palate. Black cherries, currants, and plums debut the longer you enjoy the bottle. Expect stiff tannins with oak and a delightful velvety finish. This wine will be featured in our upcoming Marietta Cellars Wine Dinner on March 19th and will be paired with fennel braised short ribs, fingerling potatoes and sage butter roasted carrots. It sells in the shoppe for \$18.99.
