April is Autism Awareness Month

Pensacola, Fla. (April 1, 2022) – Individuals on the Autism Spectrum have amazing qualities. Children who receive individualized services, based on their goals and unique learning styles, can connect well with others.

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is a great example of such a service. ABA is a research-based, scientific method that measures observable behavior. It looks at what occurs before and after a behavior. In serving people with an autism diagnosis, our team applies ABA by breaking down skills into simple steps to assist learning. A correct response is followed by positive reinforcement, which increases the likelihood that a behavior or response will be repeated. The science helps therapists develop effective treatment plans for children with developmental disabilities.

Tips for parents to help their children accept and make friends with peers on the autism spectrum include:

- 1) Be patient. Pause and allow your child time to process things and respond.
- 2) Be flexible. Children will respond to social interactions in the same ways. Just because a response doesn't meet our expectation, doesn't mean it's wrong. Play along, and have fun.
- 3) Use gestures to support your words.
- 4) Always be kind. Kindness is contagious, so spread the kindness!
