Lakeview Center partners with Magdalene's House

Pensacola, Fla. (November 14, 2022) Lakeview Center has partnered with Magdalene's House to assist women who are victims of sexual exploitation and coping with a substance use disorder. The new collaboration ensures a rapid admissions process into an intensive-outpatient program where the women can quickly begin recovery treatment in a safe environment.

"Partnering with Magdalene's House helps ensure that these survivors of trauma have access to a program where they can experience safety and compassion and be guided toward healing and recovery," said Dustin Perry, LCSW, CAP, director of Pathway and Road to Recovery at Lakeview Center.

The level of care at Pathway is twofold. Intensive treatment can address misuse. Other services, as part of a comprehensive treatment plan, can address co-occurring mental health issues. This model helps personalize care and promote recovery.

Pathway is an intensive-outpatient substance use treatment program located on Lakeview Center's main campus. Treatment is structured to serve those who need a safe and stable treatment environment where they can develop sufficient recovery skills for living their fullest life in the community.
