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SUBJECT: STRENGTHENING PUBLIC SAFETY THROUGH WORKFORCE READINESS AND INDUSTRY COMPETITIVENESS

REQUESTED ACTION:

Strengthening interagency collaboration and expanding access to regional training centers will improve coordination and operational readiness across jurisdictions.

Modernizing public safety training through the integration of data analytics, artificial intelligence (AI), simulation technology, and advanced communications systems will enhance decision-making, improve response outcomes, and position the Capital Region as a national leader in innovation.

Equally important, investments in leadership development, employee wellness, and specialized technical training are critical to sustaining a healthy, capable workforce prepared for long-term service in high-stress environments. The Public Safety team requests that our federal partners:



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- Invest in public safety workforce development and recruitment pipelines.
- Expand career-connected learning and apprenticeship programs.
- Support regional training centers and modern simulation facilities.
- Fund integration of emerging technologies (AI, data analytics, communications).
- Strengthen interagency training and coordination initiatives.
- Invest in leadership development and succession planning.
- Support workforce wellness and resilience programs.
- Increase funding for specialized and technical training (cybercrime, unmanned aircraft systems, crisis response, etc.).
