Orleans Tree Warden Recognized as Tree Warden of the Year

January 7, 2009, Sturbridge MA. The Massachusetts Tree Warden's and Forester's Association (MTWFA) presented its Seth Swift Memorial Tree Warden of the Year Award to Mr. Daniel Connolly, Tree Warden for the Town of Orleans.

Mr. Connolly has been the Town of Orleans Tree Warden for over 17 years. His stewardship of the community's trees has raised awareness in a town where outdoor views are a great priority. His ability to communicate the importance of trees and their environmental benefits has focused attention on the community forest as well as on the great ocean views.

Dan's amicable communication style and tact have helped forge a strong community alliance in Orleans. A strong network of support for the town's trees has been formed as a direct result of his ability to partner with various town departments, including the Highway Department, Parks and Beaches, Planning and private civic groups such as the Orleans Improvement Association..

Over the years Dan has accomplished:

- Received a [DCR](#) tree inventory grant to complete a town wide tree inventory.
- Completed over $\frac{3}{4}$ of a town wide tree inventory
- Used GPS to map the trees and incorporate them into the town's GIS within the [Planning Department](#).
- Organized an Annual Arbor Day Event to support community awareness and support of the town's trees.
- Served on the [Massachusetts Tree Wardens' & Foresters Association Executive Board](#) for industry involvement and public support.
- Requested and received grants for purchasing and planting of shade trees for the Town of Orleans
- Built community initiatives based on greening the town through a relationship with the [Orleans Improvement Association](#).
- Earned the 2003 CapeCod [AmeriCorps](#) Leaf Award for his excellent services as Tree Warden
- Earned Tree City USA awards for over 10 years.
