OUR STORY

In the mid 1950's, Hawaii was still a territory with an agricultural economy. Dwight Eisenhower was president of the United States and Bill Quinn was Hawaii's appointed governor.

During this time there were ten visionaries who recognized the imminence of statehood and the boom it would bring to the economy. They foresaw the importance of the building industry and understood the value of bonding together as an association to promote home building and construction. And so, in 1955, William Blackfield, Bert Kanzaki, Earl Kato, Robert M. Kaya, Ward Kegin, Robert Kuniyuki, James Lai, Melvin Muraoka, Richard Sato and Kenneth Shioi chartered the Home Builders Association of Hawaii with the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB). Based in Washington DC, the NAHB is still one of the largest and most influential trade associations in the country today.

Hawaii became the 50th State in the Union in 1959 and the Home Builders Association of Hawaii expanded its reach, ultimately becoming the Building Industry Association of Hawaii (BIA) in 1979.

Members of BIA are developers, general contractors, specialty contractors, suppliers, realtors, architects, financial institutions and a host of professionals who service the building industry. This unique mix enables members to network across their respective sectors and provides the bridging of diverse interests into a common whole, allowing the BIA to address the many challenges facing the industry with a uniquely balanced perspective.

2023 will mark our 68th year as an organization. We look forward to this year and extend a heartfelt *mahalo* to our outgoing Directors and a warm congratulations to our incoming leadership.

Huey has also chaired several NAHB committees, including BUILD-PAC, Professional Women in Building (PWB) and Membership. Huey has also served on the State & Local Government Affairs and Public Affairs and Association Communications committees, and as a member of the Executive Board. In 2008, she was named NAHB's PWB Woman of the Year.

At the local level, Huey was president of the Greater Birmingham Association of Home Builders in 2013, named the association's Builder of the Year in 2012 and inducted into its Hall of Fame in 2008. Huey was named as the Builder of the Year by the Home Builders Association of Alabama in 2014.

Huey also is active in her community. She volunteered with Habitat for Humanity for a decade, was honored as the organization's 2011 Volunteer of the Year and served as chair of the Habitat for Humanity of Greater Birmingham from 2012-2014. Huey lives in Birmingham with her husband Don, who is also active in their local home builders association through his company, Magic City Title Insurance.
