Updated SBA Certification Requirements

In Bulletin 13-2023, we provided members with a synopsis of the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Final Rule (87 FR 73400) governing Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB) and Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) certifications, which went into effect on January 1, 2023. COVID-19 Emergency Declarations Set to Expire

The COVID-19 national emergency (NE) and public health emergency (PHE) declared by the Trump administration in 2020 were set to expire on March 1st and April 11th, respectively. However, on January 30th the Biden administration notified Congress of its plan to extend the national emergency and PHE declarations to May 11th, when the emergencies will end.
