

Attendees were instructed on the proper procedures to complete Certified Payrolls as well as compliance of Prevailing Wage Laws and Regulations.



As of July 16, 2022, people are now able to use a new, easy to remember, three-digit code (988) to reach the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. The change from a standard phone number to 9-8-8 will provide easy access to crisis services for people with mental health and substance use issues and help reduce the stigma surrounding these conditions. The new 9-8-8 number is considered the 9-1-1 of mental health and substance use issues.
