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Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) Reviews

Beginning January 2, 2019, the Department of Health's process for submitting CEMPs will change for the following provider types:

- Home Health Agencies
- Nurse Registries
- Hospices
- Home Medical Equipment Providers

All CEMPs received by the Department will be reviewed for compliance with Florida Statutes and Rules. CEMPs should be submitted electronically utilizing the following link: <https://fdoh.readyop.com/fs/4cb1/1248>.

Providers licensed to operate in multiple counties are only required to submit the CEMP once and it will be distributed to all applicable County Health Departments required to conduct a review.
