At a regular session of the said Board, held in the City of White Cloud, in said County on the 26th day of October 2022, the following resolution was adopted:

**RESOLUTION #10-024-22
REQUEST A REVIEW TOWARD CONSIDERATION TO AMEND THE
MICHIGAN NO-FAULT AUTO INSURANCE REFORM ACT.**

WHEREAS, the Michigan No-Fault Auto Insurance Reform Act of 2019 introduced a fee cap, which took final effect on July 1, 2021; this cap set percentage limits on how much residential care facilities, home health care providers, and other persons can be reimbursed for providing treatment/care to auto accident victims; and

WHEREAS this greatly reduced the reimbursement rates under the Michigan Auto Insurance Fee Schedule; and

WHEREAS, as a result, home health care providers are being reimbursed at a very substantially reduced rate; and

WHEREAS, these fee caps negatively affect the auto accident victims who are receiving long-term care and rehabilitation paid for by the Michigan Catastrophic Claims Association (MCCA) through the per-vehicle annual fee that all Michigan drivers were once assessed; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Newaygo County Board of Commissioners hereby urges the Michigan Legislature to review the impact of this on Michigan citizens and consider amending the Michigan No-Fault Auto Insurance Reform Act to address a more viable reimbursement cap.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the office of Representative Scott VanSingel and Senator Jon Bumstead.


