Congratulations to SWART on the successful rollout of their brand-new "Arriba SWART" microtransit service!
Combining a brand-new transit service with a specially designed app, Arriba SWART gives riders the tools to book trips and enjoy more convenient and flexible mobility options throughout the community.





To mark the occasion, SWART debuted their fresh new fleet of vehicles in Crystal City, Carrizo Springs, Uvalde, and Eagle Pass. Each community hosted a ribbon-cutting ceremony, celebrating the arrival of this modern, rider-focused service and a big step forward in ensuring accessible and reliable transportation for the communities they serve.

The pilot period for the Arriba SWART will be through January 31, 2025. SWART is currently planning to add more zones in the next few months after the pilot period. SWART wishes to thank TxDOT for funding this service. SWART also appreciates the guidance from KFH and the Hendrickson Transportation Group in the planning and implementation of this service.



Paratransit Maintenance Training is a Success in San Antonio

We're excited to share that our Paratransit Maintenance Training, held at VIA Metropolitan Transit in San

Antonio on September 23–24, 2025, had a fantastic turnout with over 20 attendees. This event would not have been possible without the generous support and partnership of VIA.



This hands-on training provided participants with practical knowledge and skills to perform effective preventive maintenance and identify common defects in paratransit vehicles. The program

emphasized best practices in vehicle care, system troubleshooting, and maintenance documentation, equipping attendees with valuable tools to improve day-to-day operations.



Participants also worked through real-world maintenance scenarios and received take-home digital resources to support continued learning beyond the classroom. Designed specifically for paratransit maintenance technicians, this session focused on enhancing operational efficiency, minimizing vehicle downtime, and promoting the long-term safety and reliability of transit fleets. "Whether you take on-demand STARNow service or the fixed-route, STAR Transit connects you to where you want to go," adds Henricks.





Please note: We've introduced a new No-Show/Late Cancellation Fee Policy. We encourage you to review the full policy on our website or the next page of this document to ensure you're aware of the updated guidelines.

TTA's No-Show / Late Cancellation Fee Notice

To better serve our members and ensure the most efficient use of resources, the Texas Transit Association (TTA) will implement a No-Show/Late Cancellation Fee for all Statewide training courses, effective **September 1, 2025**.

While TTA continues to offer these high-quality training opportunities **at no cost to participants**, there are real costs associated with hosting each course—such as printed materials, venue arrangements, and instructor fees. When individuals fail to attend or cancel at the last minute, it can result in unused seats, wasted resources, and missed opportunities for others who would have liked to participate.

To address this challenge and promote greater accountability, TTA will begin enforcing a \$150 No-Show/Late Cancellation Fee under the following conditions:

- **No-Show**: The participant registers but does not attend the course without providing advance notice (see Cancellation Policy).
- Late Cancellation: The participant cancels less than 72 hours before the scheduled start of the course.

We understand that emergencies happen. Participants who must cancel due to unexpected circumstances may request a fee waiver by contacting TTA directly.

This policy is not intended to penalize, but rather to improve our ability to plan, reduce unnecessary costs, and **maximize participation** in these valuable training sessions. With your help, we can ensure that every available seat is filled.
