Dear Miss Exeter Candidate,

One of the highlights of the Fall season is the Miss Exeter Personal Development and Scholarship Program. This is an educational and professional experience available to incoming Exeter Union High School seniors for the 2025-2026 academic year.

The application for the Miss Exeter Program is due on Friday, August 22nd, 2025, at 2:00 PM. Please deliver your application to the CACHE Museum located at 125 South B Street, Exeter. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Applications will be reviewed, and candidates will be notified of their acceptance by phone and email.

NOTE The Exeter Woman's Club and The Miss Exeter Advisory Committee will accept up to 12 (twelve) candidates. All must meet the criteria and return the required paperwork to the CACHE Museum on or before Friday, August 22nd by 2:00 PM to be considered. The Exeter Woman's Club and the Miss Exeter Advisory Committee reserve the right to refuse any application.

Candidates are required to submit the following paperwork to be considered for the program: Candidate Application, most current report card (proof of 2.5 GPA or higher); Personal Essay, Candidate & Parent Agreement, and the Release Form.

Failure to submit all required documents will result in elimination/disqualification from the Miss Exeter Program.

The crowned Miss Exeter will receive a scholarship from the Exeter Woman's Club. Miss Runner-up will also receive a scholarship.

Enclosed is an entry form and a schedule of events. Miss Exeter and Court agree to attend the listed events during their reigning year. It is essential that candidates attend various events together.

Each candidate will be judged on the following items:

- 1. A personal essay (500-750 words) detailing her talents, school and community involvement, future plans, and goals. The judges will read the personal essay. *** If the essay is printed in the paper, The Foothills Sun Gazette reserves the right to edit essays as needed for space***
- 2. Sponsorship presentation, social media, and video posts, Sponsor Essay, and interaction with their sponsor.
- 3. Participation and cooperation during the entire program.

	1.	I am a full-time student at Exeter Unified High School or I am homeschooled in the Exeter School District. I am in the 12th grade (Senior Fall 2025 with a GPA higher than 2.50). I have not been involved, will not at any time, not during my participation as a Miss Exeter candidate or as a future member of the Court, will I become involved in any conduct or activity that could cause embarrassment to the Exter Woman's Club, the City of Exeter, and/or all other Miss Exeter candidates.
	2.	I agree to fully participate in the scheduled events leading up to and following the selection of Miss Exeter and abide by and be bound by the rules and regulations governing the Miss Exeter program. Failure to complete all required assignments as scheduled could result in elimination from the Miss Exeter program. Special arrangements must be made in advance between the candidate and the Exeter Woman's Club if the candidate will miss any meeting or scheduled events.
	3.	If I am selected as Miss Exeter, I agree to make myself available for public appearances required of me by the Exeter Woman's Club. I will refer all requests for public appearances to the Exeter Woman's Club. When appearing as Miss Exeter, I will always dress appropriately for the occasion.
	4.	Dress guidelines are indicated for each event. For the Miss Exeter Coronation Dinner, please wear a floor-length formal dress. Low cut back/tops, strapless, bare/sheer midriffs, or cut-out dresses are not acceptable. Straps must be at least 1/2 inch wide. Modesty is the best policy. Proper undergarments must be worn at all times. Shoes must not exceed 3 inches in height, including platform shoes. Candidates must wear approved formal dresses for future events (as listed). Your assigned Miss Exeter Committee Member will approve your coronation gown and shoes.
	5.	I agree that the manner and method of conducting the Miss Exeter program shall be in the sole discretion of the Miss Exeter Committee and the Exeter Woman's Club. I further agree that the time, method, and manner of judging of Miss Exeter and the awarding of the scholarship shall be within the sole discretion of the Committee under the direction of the Exeter Woman's Club. I also agree that the decisions of the persons designated to judge the various events in all matters pertaining to the selection of winners shall be final.
	6.	I agree to conduct myself in a manner which, in the opinion of the Miss Exeter Advisory Committee and/or the Exeter Woman's Club, upholds and maintains the dignity and honor of the title "Miss Exeter" and does not cause embarrassment to the Exeter Woman's Club, the City of Exeter, and/or all other Miss Exeter Candidates. I understand and agree that they have the exclusive prerogative to terminate my right to participate in the Miss Exeter program, as well as my right to the title of Miss Exeter and all awards and scholarships pertaining thereto.
