

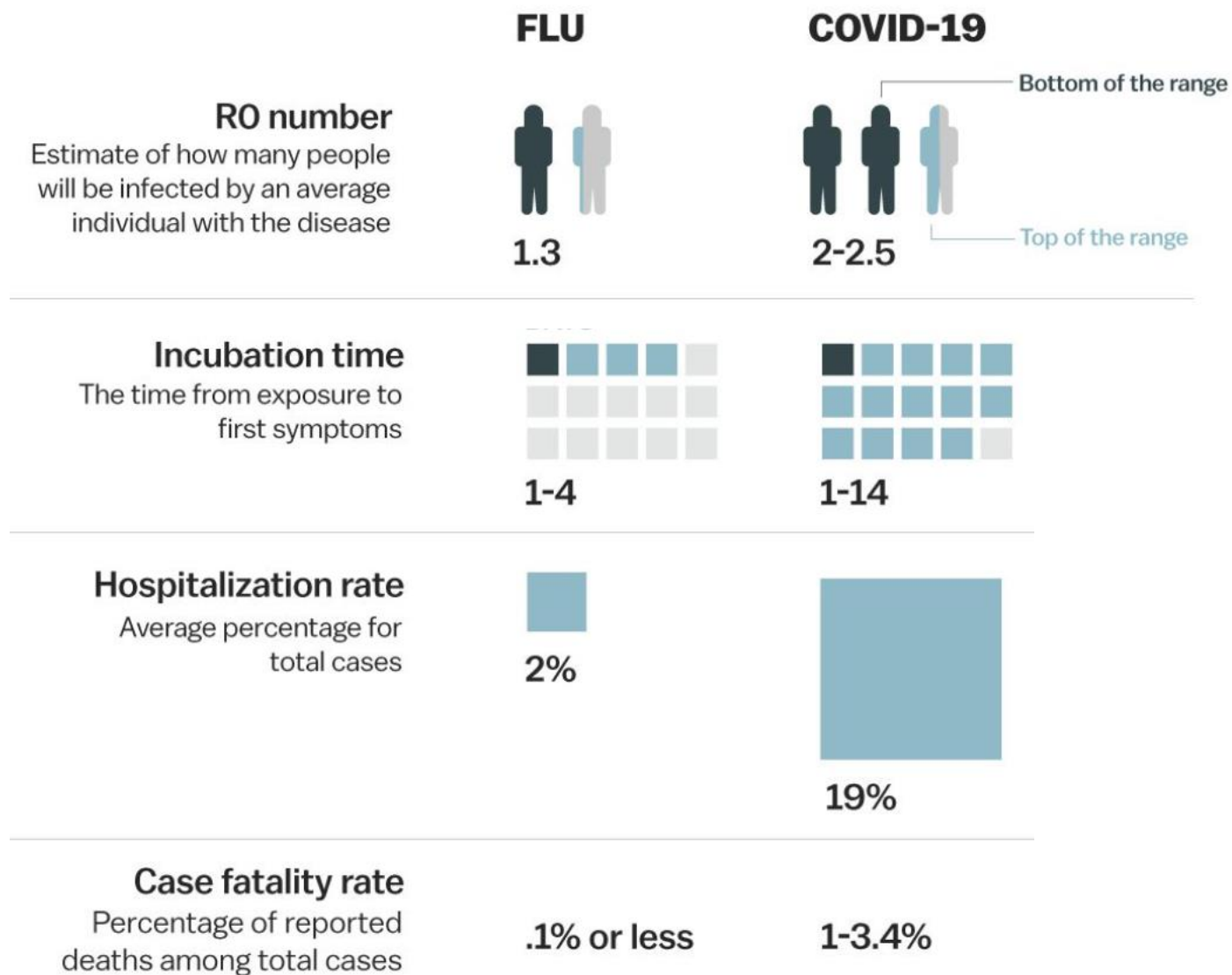

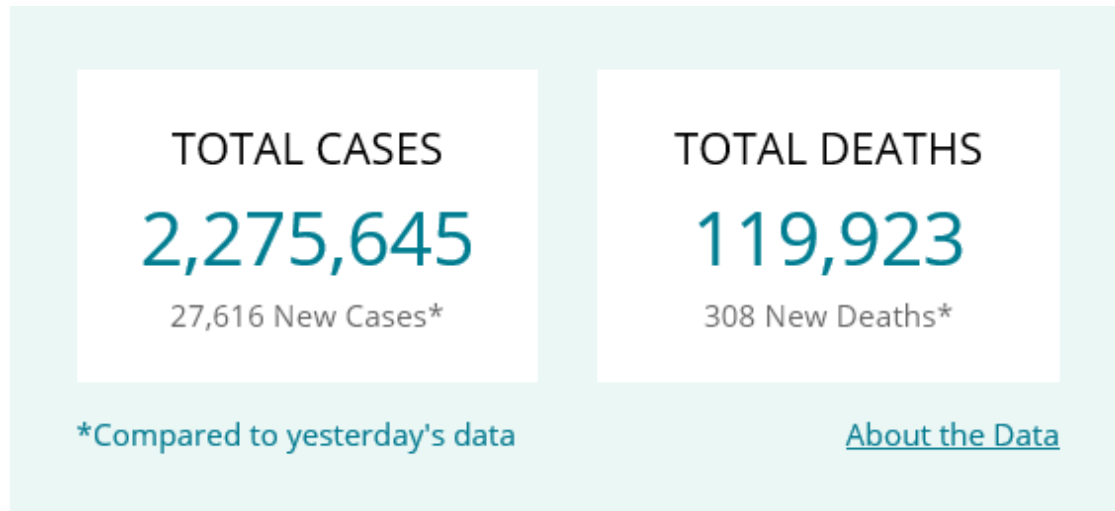

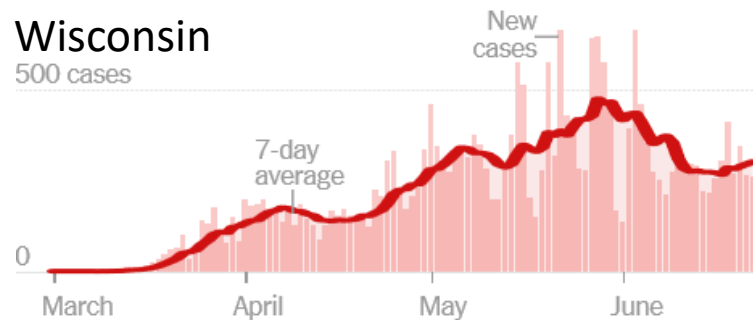
- 23 state experiencing an uptick in cases and ICUs in South Florida, Arizona, Texas and Southern California are nearing capacity

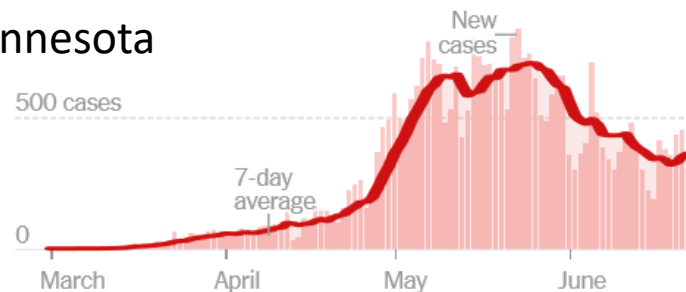

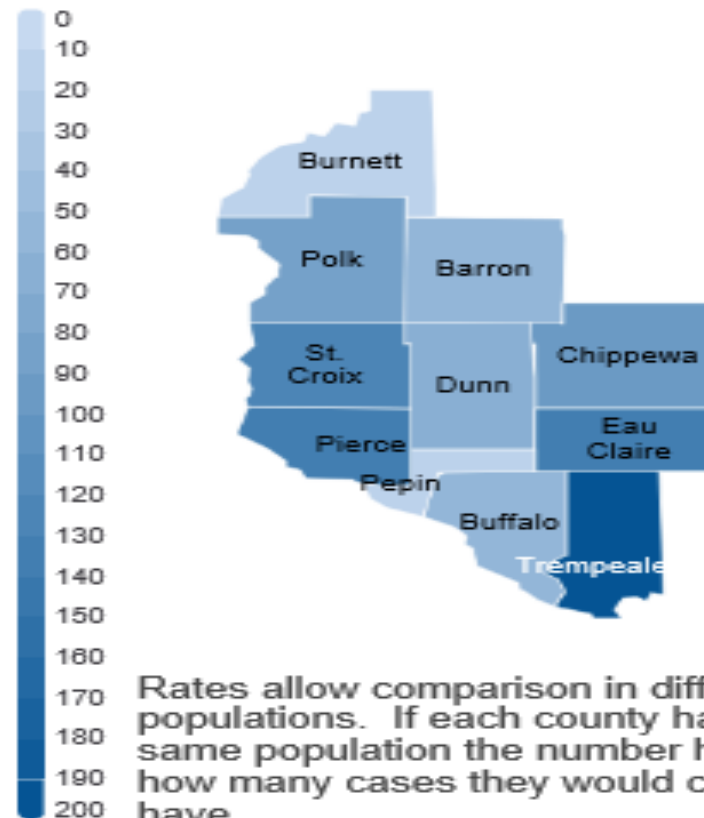

Symptoms of COVID-19 include: fever, cough, chills, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, fatigue, muscle aches, loss of taste and/or smell, nausea, abdominal pain, and diarrhea.

What does the modelling show now?


- **Modeling**

- Key inputs from 5 epidemiologic models are incorporated into Allina's internal forecasted demand which drives surge capacity planning
- Models are actively updated as new data becomes available

Projected Peak/Plateau: Wisconsin and Minnesota seeing a downward trend and will hopefully maintain at a level that allows us to manage safely

- Surge capacity and workforce planning complete
- Bringing Care Back Safely in Wisconsin and Minnesota

What's Happening at Allina Health:

- Universal Masking of employees, patients and visitors
- Full screening of all employees, patients and visitors including temperature
- From Virtual Care  to Safe In Clinic Care keeping virtual
- Continued restriction of visitors to hospitals or clinics but should see less restrictions soon
- Bring Back Care Safely – Need to do Surgery, procedures and imaging

What's happening in River Falls Area Hospital and Clinic?

- Tiered Approach to Surge Planning - well prepared and ready
- Extensive training of Nurses, Respiratory Therapists and Physicians for Covid19 and expanded roles
- Virtual Teams for ED, ICU and MS using Ipads for communication with patients under investigation
- Virtual visits with increasing in-person visits to our Non Respiratory Clinic with pre-op testing
- Curb side testing for COVID-19 including no symptoms if took part in a protest available

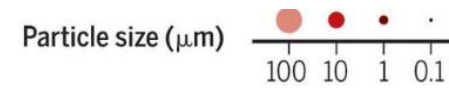
COVID-19 RESPONSE

- Procure critical care supplies

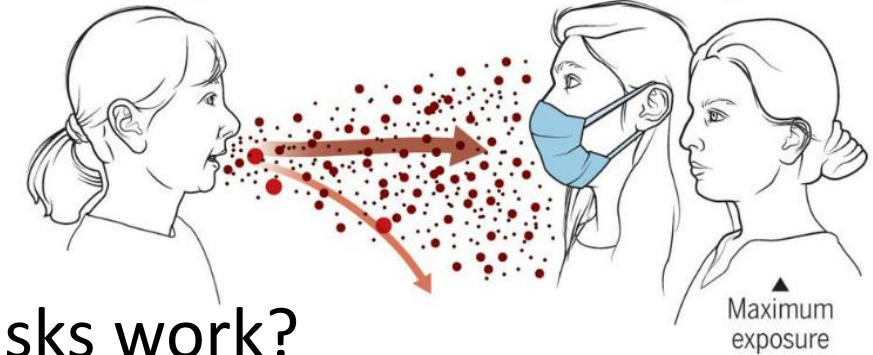

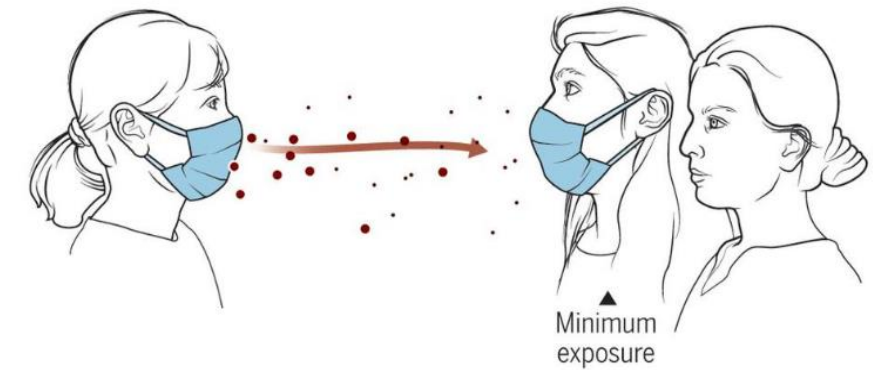
