Troy Area Chamber

THE VOICE OF BUSINESS

- Advocates for a strong business climate
- Connects, educates and promotes businesses
- Supports workforce and leadership development
- Does not approve zoning, permits or projects



Troy Development Council

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PARTNER

- Supports business attraction, retention and expansion
- Connects investors with sites, partners and resources
- Promotes Troy for jobs and investment
- Does not make governmental approvals



City of Troy

PUBLIC SERVICES + ADMINISTRATION

- Provides infrastructure and municipal services
- Administers zoning, building and permitting processes
- Reviews plans and prepares recommendations
- Carries out decisions of public bodies



Planning Commission

LAND USE + DEVELOPMENT REVIEW

- Reviews certain zoning and development matters
- Evaluates proposals against adopted requirements
- Receives public input through established processes
- Acts within authority granted by law



Troy City Council

ELECTED LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

- Adopts ordinances and public policy
- Approves certain zoning and development actions
- Considers budgets, expenditures and public input
- Makes formal decisions in public meetings



Miami County

COUNTYWIDE GOVERNMENT + SERVICES

- Provides regional public services and infrastructure
- Supports planning, health, safety and human services
- Maintains property, tax and court functions
- Participates when county authority applies



Troy Main Street

DOWNTOWN VITALITY

- Supports downtown businesses and property owners
- Leads events, promotion and placemaking
- Advances preservation and beautification
- Strengthens the downtown experience



The Troy Foundation

COMMUNITY PHILANTHROPY

- Manages charitable funds and donor investments
- Awards grants to community organizations
- Supports local priorities and nonprofit capacity
- Operates independently from government and TACC/TDC
