Subject: Use of Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare (2023)

Motion:

I move to amend 2023 as follows:

IPhA recognizes the increasing role of artificial intelligence in pharmacy practice. Licensed pharmacists are responsible for patient care and outcomes, critically assessing AI recommendations while retaining full accountability for clinical decisions.

IPhA supports the use of artificial intelligence in healthcare <u>limited to the role of gathering data, analyzing</u> <u>trends, and</u> as a clinical <u>assistant</u> <del>tool</del> in the pharmacist clinical decision making and recommendations for therapeutic options for a patient's care.

IPhA opposes the use of artificial intelligence in any way to <u>that</u> replaces or supersedes a pharmacist's or other <u>health care</u> <u>healthcare</u> provider's scope of practice, <u>duty of care</u>, or <u>patient</u> access to care. <del>practice or delivery</del> and duty of care for a patient.

IPhA encourages training for pharmacists, pharmacist extenders, and other healthcare workers and healthcare professionals on how AI systems work, including their limitations, potential for bias, and how to interpret AI recommendations.
