The Oklahoma Coaches Association is pleased to announce that thirteen individuals from across the State of Oklahoma will be inducted into the Oklahoma Coaches Hall of Fame during the annual OCA Coaches Clinic and All State week this summer. The induction ceremony and banquet will be held at the Nigh University Center located on the campus of the University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond, on Saturday, July 25, 2026, at 6:30 p.m.

This year, inductees fall into all three of the OCA's Hall of Fame categories. The Coaches Hall of Fame Inductees are individuals in the High School coaching profession that have fifteen (15) years as a head coach, or 25 total years as a head coach, head junior high coach, or assistant high school coach in Oklahoma. Distinguished Service inductees are those people in the coaching profession that have made a direct contribution to athletics in Oklahoma, but do not have the required number of high school years' service; or, those officials, athletic trainers, players, etc., that have made a direct contribution to the growth and well-being of the Oklahoma Coaches Association. Special Service inductees are individuals outside the coaching profession that have made a direct contribution to athletics in Oklahoma, such as a sports aficionado, sports journalist, etc.
