Overview of Program

This two-day program offers the latest practical techniques and tools to help participants unlock their leadership potential. These new skills will give them more confidence and self-assurance, enabling them to be stronger leaders in their organization and all aspects of life.

Applicant Requirements

- Applicant must be employed at a current member company of the California Trucking Association.
- Applicants must be recommended and approved by a senior executive within their company.
- Applicants are required to complete the CliftonStrengths Assessment (an online test) prior to
 the start of the Leadership Academy. Upon acceptance into the program, an access code and
 assessment book will be mailed to the address provided. The cost of the assessment is included
 in the Academy registration fee.
- Ideal candidates for the Leadership Academy include:
 - o Individuals identified as future senior corporate executives
 - Current managers
 - High-potential entry-level managers

Application Process

The Leadership Academy fee is \$699 and includes two days of classes, continental breakfast and lunch on both days, and a networking reception the evening of the 17th. The required class text, **Strengths-Based Leadership: Great Leaders, Teams, and Why People Follow** by Tom Rath, is also included.

Admission to the CTA Leadership Academy is open on a first-come, first-served basis. The program is limited to 30 participants. Applications and payments are due by **September 12, 2025**. If you qualify for the program, you will be notified within three business days of submitting your application.

The candidate's application package must contain the following documents:

- The Leadership Academy application
- Business résumé
- One letter of reference from the candidate's company senior executive outlining the candidate's
 potential, decision-making abilities, accomplishments, and goals. This letter must also include a
 statement affirming the company's commitment to the program by providing time for the
 candidate to complete the necessary work and travel to the seminar.
- A short and brief essay describing the reasons the participant is interested in the program, what he or she hopes to gain from participating, and their long-term goals within the industry.
