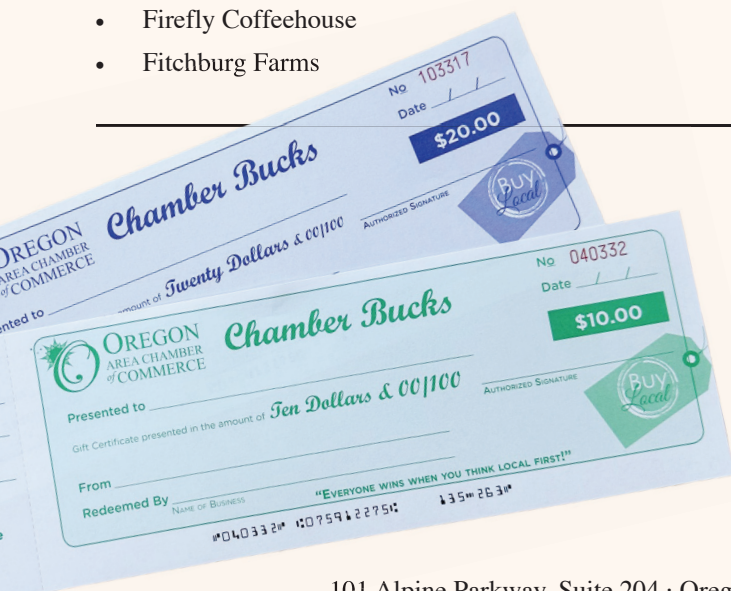
ABOUT CHAMBER BUCKS
