About CMAA Connecticut Chapter Scholarship

The Construction Management Association of America (CMAA) Connecticut Chapter is awarding scholarships to qualified students to help them defray the costs of **pursuing a degree in Construction Management, Civil Engineering, or other related fields.** The value of each scholarship is \$1,000 or greater, based on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.

Students may also be eligible to apply CMAA Foundation Scholarships (see www.cmaafoundation.org for additional information).

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. For high school seniors or current undergraduate students, must be contingent on acceptance to attend a full-time accredited college or university in the next academic year or currently enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university. For graduate students, must be accepted to attend a graduate program or currently enrolled in a graduate program at an accredited college or university. Undergraduate students must have a minimum of one full academic year left. Graduate students must have a minimum of two courses left.
- 2. Must be contingent on acceptance to or enrolled in a Construction Management, Civil Engineering, or related degree program at an accredited college or university, and show a strong interest in a career in Construction Management, as demonstrated by a response to the essay question in the application package.
- 3. Must have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- 4. Must be contingent on acceptance to attend or attending a college or university located in Connecticut or be a Connecticut State Resident.

NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be considered. The application and all associated attachments must be submitted electronically. Hard copies of transcripts, essays, and recommendations must be scanned and sent electronically. Hard copy applications and attachments will not be considered. Applications submitted using ChatGPT or similar applications will not be considered for award.

CMAA Connecticut Chapter Scholarship Application Process

All applications and supporting materials must be submitted directly to the CMAA Connecticut Chapter. **Be sure to** fill out the application completely and submit it with all accompanying attachments electronically to scholarship@ctcmaa.starchapter.com no later than midnight, October 17, 2024.

You should receive a confirmation email that your application was submitted successfully (please be sure to check your Spam folder, as well). If you do not receive a confirmation, please email Terrence McAuliffe at tmcauliffe@aiengineers.com of the issue.

The Academic/Facility Advisor Evaluation Form & Recommendation Statement on the last page of this application should be provided to your academic advisor, student councilor or an instructor for their recommendation, which they will submit directly to the CMAA Connecticut Chapter.

CMAA Connecticut Chapter Scholarship Review Process

- 1. The CMAA Connecticut Chapter scholarship selection committee will review all complete applications received and make its recommendations to the CMAA Connecticut Chapter Board of Directors for approval. The selected winner will be notified on or about November 8, 2024.
- 2. While not mandatory, the scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to attend the CMAA Awards & Scholarship dinner on November 21, 2024, at The Aqua Turf Club in Southington, CT. The selected student will be recognized at the event.


CMAA Connecticut Chapter Selection Criteria

The CMAA Connecticut Chapter scholarship selection committee will consider the following in selecting the winner of the scholarship:

- Academic performance: 40%
- Quality of essay on future plans and scholarship interest: 20%
- Recommendation of faculty advisor: 15%
- Extracurricular activities: 25%
- BONUS: Student member of CMAA: 5%

Helpful Hints

- All sections of the application, including the Application Checklist, must be completed in full and submitted electronically. An application submitted missing any of the sections and without a signature will be disqualified from consideration.
- The response to the essay must be typed. Be sure to check spelling and grammar carefully. Please remember that your application will be scanned and disseminated to the selection committee electronically; presentation is important. Any essay submitted using ChatGPT or similar will not be considered.
- The subject line of your email when submitting should include your last name and school name. Please
 submit one email with all completed sections of the application, in one PDF document, including the
 transcripts but not the Advisor's portion as that is sent by your Advisor directly to
 scholarship@ctcmaa.starchapter.com. Applications received with several individual pieces will be returned
 for consolidation.
- Please keep a copy of your complete application package and request proof of electronic delivery. The
 returned proof of delivery will serve as verification that your application has been received. No additional
 notification will be provided.
