# Legislative Overview: What We Tracked

- Bills Introduced in Colorado Legislative Session 2025:
  - **657 Bills**  
**(House: 335 /Senate: 322)**
- Bills Passed: **585**
- Bills Tracked: **178**
- Bills Pl'd: **171**





# HB25-1005: Tax Incentive for Film Festivals

The bill creates two refundable state income tax credits to support Colorado's film festival industry, administered by the Colorado Office of Economic Development (OEDIT)



**Chamber Position:** Support  
**Final Outcome:** Signed into law



# **SB25-161: Transit Reform**

The bill creates new requirements for the Regional Transportation District (RTD) with the goal of improving its performance.



**Chamber Position:** Support

**Final Outcome:** Signed into law (Highlight: Saved Gunbarrel Service)



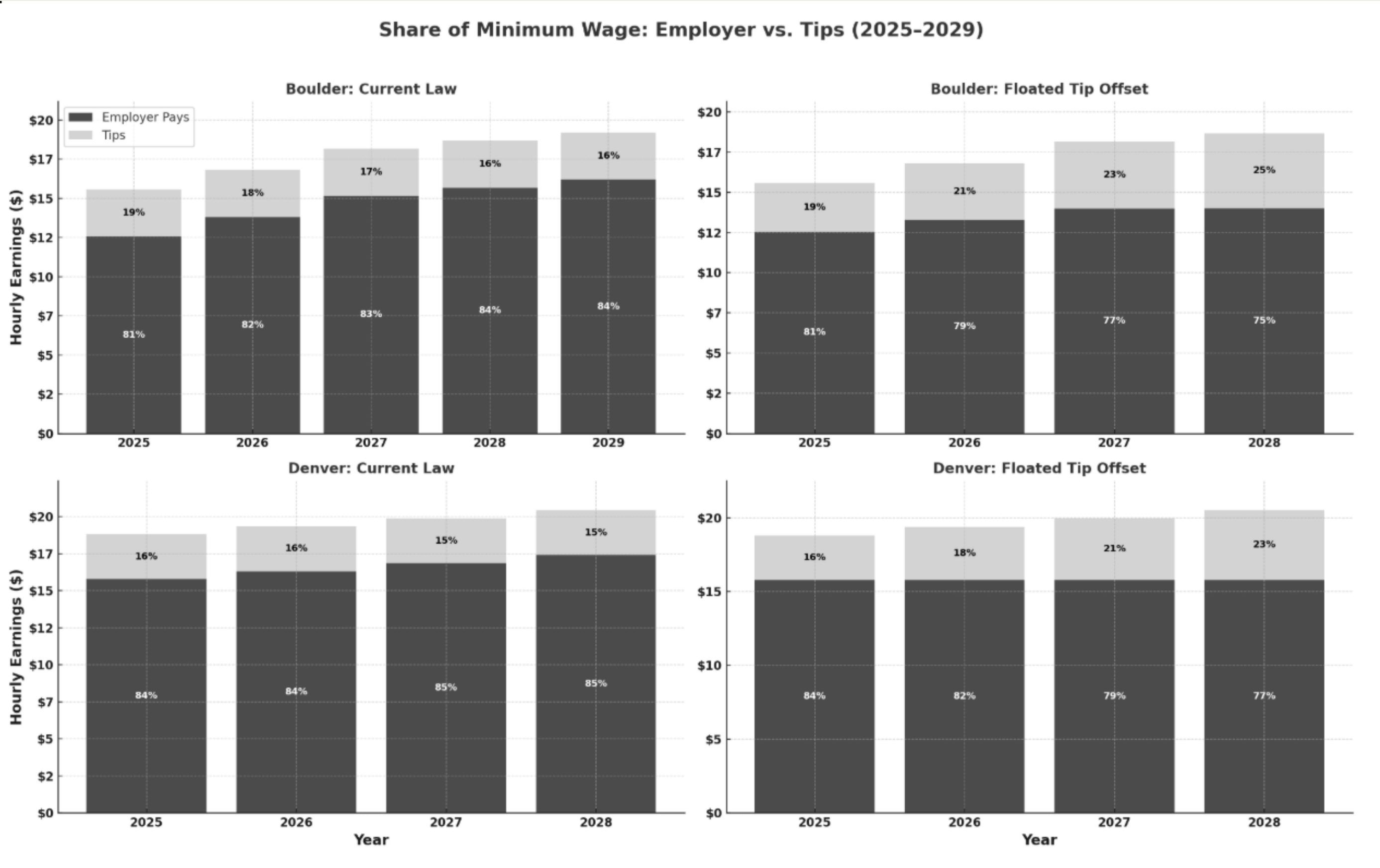
# HB25-1208: Tipped Wage Credit

Supports restaurants by allowing Local Governments to increase the tip credit .

# **HB25-1272: Construction Defects**

The bill creates the Multifamily Construction Incentive Program to limit the grounds for which a construction defect can be claimed against participating builders.

## **Summary:**

- It specifies additional criteria that must be satisfied to file a construction defect on applicable middle market.
- For housing in the program sold on or after January 1, 2026, the bill creates an eight-year statute of limitations for construction defect claims
- Builders may participate in the program by providing warranties against defects that meet certain standards and by conducting third-party inspections.

**Chamber Position:** Support

**Final Outcome:** Signed into law

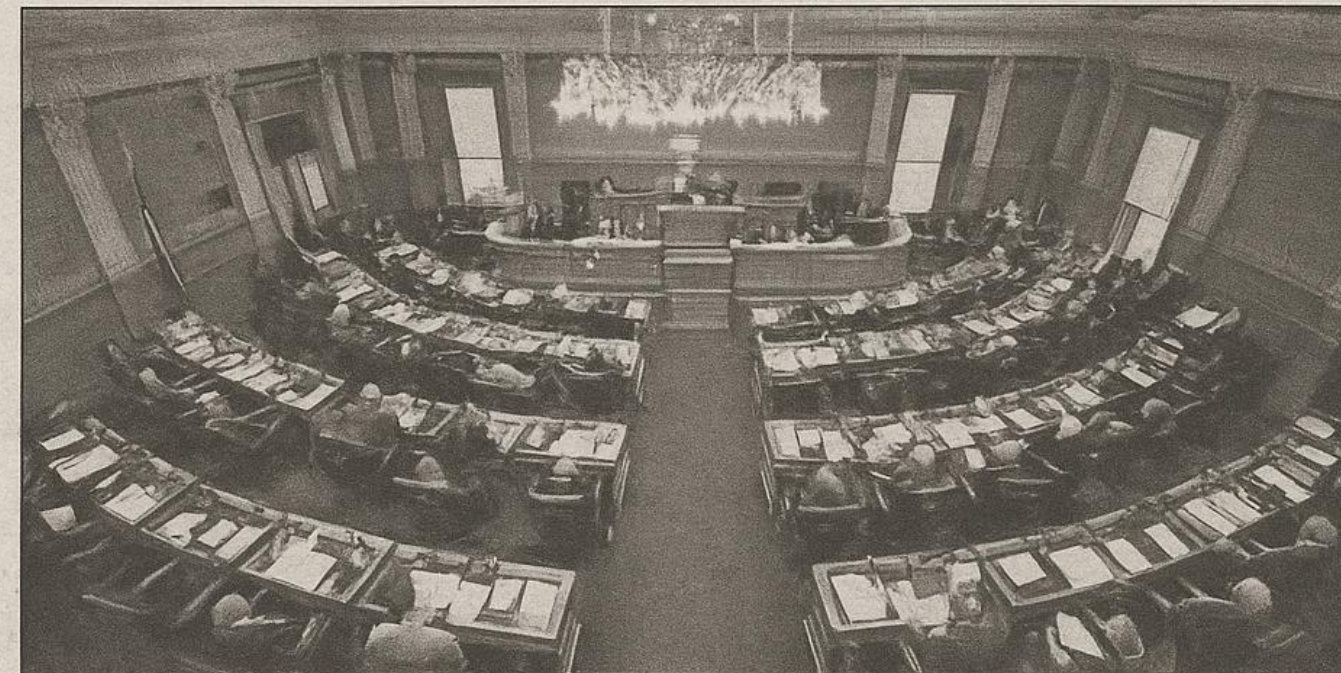
