**Setup:** From 10:00 AM

**Event Start:** 1:00 PM (Priority Access) 2pm (General Admission)

**Event Ends:** 5:00 PM | Cleanup by 8:00 PM

**Address:** Louisville Community Park, 955 Bella Vista Dr., Louisville, CO 80027

**Load-In:** Curb drop-off 10:00–11:30 AM at South Entrance on Bella Vista Dr.

**Note:** *No VIP this year instead priority access 1 hour before general admission.*

#### **Beverage Samples:**

- Customers will have 5oz taster glasses for 3 oz pours.
- We will not be selling drinks tickets or full beverage pours.
- Samples only.

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#### **INVOICE DETAILS**

The Louisville Chamber is a nonprofit 501(c)(6) organization and Pints in the Park is one of our major annual fundraising events. We are incredibly grateful to our beverage partners who participate by offering products at a discounted wholesale price. Your support directly helps fund our programs for local businesses and the community.

- Please invoice the Louisville Chamber of Commerce, 901 Main Street, Louisville, CO 80027 after the event based on the following:

#### **Breweries**

\$175 per ½ keg or equivalent (165 cans), providing approximately 500 3 oz pours including standard waste. If additional product is used during the event, you may invoice up to one additional ½ keg. Maximum total per brewery: \$350.

#### **Distilleries & Wineries**

Up to \$200 wholesale contribution. If selling full bottles, prior Chamber approval is required. Distilleries must provide sealed bags. No on-site consumption of bottled product is permitted. All required sales tax licenses must be in place.

#### **Non-Alcoholic Beverage Vendors**

Up to \$100 wholesale contribution. Sampling and on-site sales are permitted.

#### **Excess Product – Cans Only**

Any remaining product may be left behind your tent at the end of the event. Our volunteers will collect it and use it at future Chamber events.

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## **YOU MUST PROVIDE**

- 10x10 tent (with water or freestanding weights) **NO STAKES in grass.**
- Table(s), chairs, serving equipment
- Your own product (beer, spirits, NA)

## **WE WILL PROVIDE**

- Ice will be provided onsite
- Drinking Water refill stations available | Use Pavilion tap for weights

## **POWER**

**NO POWER PROVIDED** (*reach out if this is an issue, we have a couple of sites we can access limited power if needed*)

## **TRASH**

- No dumping beverages into the grass / ice is ok but spread out please.
- Dumpster is available for trash, no trash allowed in city bins.

## **SERVING AT PINTS**

- If you believe a guest should stop drinking, please notify event manager and refuse service. You may suggest they switch to a Designated Driver wristband. If needed, a police officer will assist with a safe exit. Water, snacks, and transportation support will be available near the exit.

## **WRISTBANDS & ID**

All guests will have wristbands after ID check at entry.

- Red = VIP | Blue = General Admission | Black & White = Designated Driver

**No wristband = No alcohol, even with a glass**

## **IN CASE OF EMERGENCY / POLICE/ FIRST AID**

Notify Event Manager or a Police Officer on Duty. If in doubt, call 911 without delay.

If immediate exit is required remove the flags on the perimeter to allow fast exit.

Limited basic first aid box at the Chamber Desk Entrance.
