



2019 National Crochet Month Crochet-Along All Buttoned Up Neck Cozy Pattern

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It only takes basic beginner crochet skills to create this snugly neck cozy. Using only chain and single crochet stitches, you will have a warm accessory that you will be proud to wear or give as a gift. We've shown a variety of yarns that can be used to make this quick-to-make neck warmer.

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Measurements

Approx. 9" (22.9cm) wide x 29.75" (75.5cm) long (It is easily made longer.)

Materials

See separate Yarn Information page in the Group Forum or Blog for the variety of yarns used for photography models.

Crochet Hook

See separate Yarn Information page for the size of hooks used for each yarn.

Extras

2 stitch markers
Yarn Needle
5 – 5/8" shank buttons

Gauge

16 sc x 16 rows = 4 in. square (Gauge is not critical for this project but the gauge given will give you an idea of what was achieved with the various yarns.)

Abbreviations

ch = chain
RS = Right Side
sc = single crochet
sp(s) = space(s)

Pattern Note

Use a stitch marker in the ch-2 sp at start of each row to make it easy to find when working into it on next row.

Instructions

Row 1 (RS): Ch 37; working stitches into the back ridge of the ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (36 sc)

Row 2: Ch 2, turn, skip first st, sc in next st, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 17 times. (1 ch-2 sp, 17 ch-1 sps, 18 sc)

Row 3: Ch 2, turn, skip first st, [sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next st] 17 times, sc in last ch-2 sp. (1 ch-2 sp, 17 ch-1 sps, 18 sc)

Rows 4 - 116: Repeat Row 3.

Row 117 (button holes): Ch 2, turn, skip first st, sc in next ch-1 sp, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 3, skip 3 sts, sc in next ch-1 sp] 5 times, ch 1, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sc in last ch-2 sp. (1 ch-2 sp, 7 ch-1 sps, 5 ch-3 sps, 13 sc)

Row 118: Ch 2, turn, skip first st, (sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next st) 2 times, [(sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, skip next st, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, skip next st] 5 times, sc in last ch-2 sp. (1 ch-2 sp, 17 ch-1 sps, 18 sc)

Row 119: Repeat Row 3. Fasten off.

Finishing

With yarn needle, weave in ends. Sew on buttons to RS on opposite end from button holes a half inch into left edge.

NOTE: The model made with Landscapes was made longer. Susan said, "The sample I made fit my skinny dress form with 119 Rows but didn't fit **my** neck and shoulders comfortably so I added more rows repeating Row 3 as stated through Row 134.

I started my button holes on Row 135 so my Rows 135-137 are the same as Rows 117-119 of the written pattern. It also allowed me to wrap one end over the other to achieve a slightly different styling. I had plenty of yarn to crochet the additional rows and still had some left over".
