Blankets (Completed or Squares)	
Binky Patrol	Handmade blankets for children and teens from one day to 18 years old who are ill, abused, or experiencing any kind of trauma.
Blankets for Canada Society	The mission is to give crocheting and knitting free of charge to those absence of shelter or in need of warmth in Canada.
Bridget's Cradles	Bridget's Cradles are designed to hold tiny babies who are born into Heaven during the second trimester of pregnancy. Because babies are so small and fragile in weeks 14-26 of pregnancy, traditional blankets do not meet their needs. Our cradles offer a functional and stable way to hold a delicate, precious baby, and each cradle is uniquely made with love and care to respect the sacred life it will hold.

Bundles of Love	Since 2001, creating bundles full of newborn basic clothing, bedding, and hygiene items. Special focus of sleep sacks, newborn size sweater sets (we appreciate it if bonnets/hats, booties are included), and baby afghans which are used for "tummy time".
Click for Babies	Period of PURPLE Crying caps is a campaign to make purple colored baby caps as a reminder about normal infant crying, ways to cope with the crying and the dangers of reacting in frustration by shaking or abusing an infant.
Newborns in Need	Provides care necessities to agencies and hospitals serving premature, ill, or impoverished newborns. Newborns In Need distributes items free of charge to babies in the United States.

Touching Little Lives	Supplying crochet items of afghans, sweaters, hats, booties and burial layettes in preemie and newborn sizes to needy, premature and newborn babies in Ohio. Donations supply more than 15 hospitals, family service agencies and women's shelters.

Awesome Breast Forms	Creating handmade prosthetic breast forms for women who have had breast surgery, including mastectomy, lumpectomy, explant surgery and women with developmental conditions.
Knitted Knockers	Creating handmade breast prosthesis for women who have undergone mastectomies or other procedures to the breast. Connect volunteer knitters and crocheters with breast cancer survivors to offer free Knitted Knockers to any woman who wants them.
Peyton Heart Project	A global project created to help end suicide and bullying and the stigma surrounding mental health issues, through the creation of hearts and affirmative messages.
