Impressionist Cowl

Finished Measurements

Approx 66" (167.6cm)
circumference x 6" (15.2cm) wide

Materials

- RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™, worsted weight: 70% acrylic, 30% wool; 3.5oz/100g, 151yd/138m per ball
- 1 ball #1919 Watercolors

Crochet Hook

US L-11 (8mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

Extras

- Yarn needle

Gauge

11 sc = 4" (10cm); 5 shell rows = 4" (10cm)

Special Stitches

Shell: Work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in specified st or sp.

Pattern Notes

Cowl is crocheted in flat rows, then sewn together to form a tube.

Instructions

Ch 182.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each rem ch; ch 3 (counts as first dc on following row here and throughout), turn. (181 sc)

Row 2 (RS): *Sk next 2 sc, shell in next sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next sc; rep from * across; ch 3, turn. (30 shells)

Row 3: *Shell in ch-2 sp of next shell, dc in next dc; rep from * across, working last dc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3; ch 3, turn.

Rows 4-8: Rep Row 3, 5 times.

Row 9: Ch 2, sl st in ch-2 sp of next shell, ch 2, dc in next dc; rep from * across, working last dc in 3rd ch of turning ch-3. Fasten off, leaving long end for sewing.

Assembly

Matching ends of rows, sew together, forming a continuous circle. ●
