

LIMEADE SHAWL

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Special Stitches

Reverse Single Crochet (rsc):

Insert the hook, from front to back, in the next stitch to the right (if you crochet right-handed). Yarn over and draw through. Yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.

Shawl

Row 1: With larger hook ch 6, dc in the 4th ch from hook and in each of last 2 chs, turn. (ch-3 sp, 3 dc; 1 segment)

Row 2: Ch 6, dc in the 4th ch from hook and in each of next 2 chs, flip the 1st segment up and sl st in the ch sp, (ch 3, 3 dc) into the ch sp, turn. (2 segments)

Row 3: Ch 6, dc in the 4th ch from hook and in each of next 2 chs, sl st in next ch-3 sp of the previous segment, (ch 3, 3 dc) into the ch sp, sl st in next ch-3 sp (ch 3, 3 dc) into the ch sp, turn. (3 segments)

Row 4: Ch 6, dc in the 4th ch from hook and in each of next 2 chs, (sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) into next ch-3 sp across, turn. (4 segments)

Rows 5-46: Continue repeating

Row 4 increasing one segment every row, turn. (46 segments)

Row 47: (Ch 3, 2 dc) in 1st st, *sl st in next ch sp, 3 dc in the sl st between segments, rep from * across to last ch sp, 3 dc in the 1st ch of the last ch-3 sp, turn.

Row 48: Ch 1, sc in each dc and sl st to the end of the row. Do not turn

Row 49: With smaller hook, ch 1 and rsc to the end of the row, turn.

Edging

Row 1: With larger hook and working down the side of the triangle, work 2 sc over length of each parallel dc, and sc in bottom of each perpendicular dc across to the corner, 3 sc in the corner st, continue up the other side the same as the 1st side, 2 sc in the last st, turn.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), [skip next sc, (dc, ch 1) in next sc] 59 times to the corner st, (dc, ch 2, dc, ch 1) in corner st, [skip next sc, (dc, ch 1) in next sc] 59 times to the end of the row, end with a dc in the last st, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, *ch 4, skip next 2 ch-1 sps, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-1 sp, ch 4, skip next 2 ch-1 sps, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, repeat from * across to corner ch-2, (ch 4, 2 dc, ch 4, 2 dc) in corner ch-2 sp, continue to rep from * to * again up the other side until 4 ch-1 sps rem, ch 4, skip 2 ch-1 sps, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc, sc in next ch-1 sp, sc in last dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each of first 4 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp,* ch 3, (3 dc, ch 4, 3 dc) in next ch-3 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, rep from * across to

Skill Level: Easy

Finished Measurements:

59" across by 39" deep

Materials:

Caron Simply Soft worsted weight (100% Acrylic; 6oz [170g], 315yds [288m]); Pistachio, 3 skeins

Crochet Hook:

Sizes J/10 (6mm) and H/8 (5mm)

Extras: Yarn Needle

Gauge: Gauge is not critical for this pattern.

corner, ch 4 (3 dc, ch 5, 3 dc) in corner ch-4 sp, ch 4, sc in next ch sp, sc in next 3 sc and next ch sp, rep from * to * across other side, sc in each of last 4 sc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 4 sc, * ch 4, (dc, ch 1) 6 times in next ch-4 sp, dc in same ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, sk last sc, repeat from * across to corner, ch 5 (dc, ch 1) 8 times in corner ch-5 sp, dc in same ch-5 sp, ch 5, skip first sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, rep from * to * across other side, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each of next 3 sc * ch 4 (sc, ch 1) in each of the next 5 ch-1 sps, sc in next ch 1 sp, ch 4, skip first sc, sc in next sc, rep from * across to corner, ch 5, (sc, ch 1) in each of next 4 ch-1 sps, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 5, skip first sc, sc in next sc, rep from * to * across other side, sc in each of last 2 sc. Fasten off.

Finishing

With yarn needle, weave in all ends.

This shawl is as delicious as a cold glass of limeade – but will keep the chill away! It's easy to crochet with a simple repeat – you'll have it finished in no time.
