## Strategic Legislative Principles:

- Support policies that enhance job creation, innovation, and capital investment in the Metrocrest area economy and overall community.
- Support policies that will foster a favorable business climate and grow Metrocrest economic development.
- Support policies that streamline processes, and reduce undue burden whenever and wherever possible which includes but is not limited to unfunded mandates, taxes, fees, etc.

## We Support:

- Workforce & Education:
  - Funding workforce development programs that foster career exploration and technical programs which build next generation workforce and leaders.
  - Increase funding for the Skills Development Fund grants to improve workforce training.
  - Continuing investments and updates to the community college finance legislation.
  - Continuing investments in Small Business Development Centers and their professional business advising and training programs for small business owners.
  - Restoring public school funding to levels established by HB3 (2019), when accounting for inflation.
- Transportation and Infrastructure:
  - A well maintained, planned, and operated transportation network that is adequately funded for future growth and capacity.
  - Support innovative financing tools that leverage state funds to expedite delivery of needed infrastructure construction and maintenance projects.
  - Strengthening Texas' aging infrastructure through dedicated funding sources for adequate water planning and supply, safe and efficient modes of transportation, reliable energy production and delivery, and accessible broadband service.
- Quality of Life
  - Funding safe and secure communities, access to affordable housing and health care, favorable taxes, and regulatory freedom for businesses.
  - Funding to improve access to in/out-patient behavioral and mental health.
