1. What is EPIC?

 Led by the U.S. Chamber Foundation, EPIC (Employer Provided Innovation Challenges) connects employers with students and learners through authentic, project-based learning opportunities

2. How can my organization get involved?

4. What kind of projects can we create?

 Projects should be authentic and address real business needs and be designed to provide valuable learning experiences for participants.

5. How do I collaborate with a clearinghouse?

 EPIC's clearinghouses will help connect you with educational institutions and workforce partners to help implement and manage your projects.

6. What is the commitment required from my organization?

Your organization's responsibilities include: designing the challenge scenario and
providing essential background resource materials, participating in final presentations to
review project findings and providing feedback to learners. Your organization may opt to
provide additional sessions for learners, such as a Q&A opportunity, etc.

7. Are there any costs involved?

Currently there are no costs to participate. The U.S. Chamber of Commerce Foundation
provides access to the Riipen technology platform, digital badges through Credly, and
staff to guide and support your projects.

8. How can I measure the impact of my project?

• EPIC provides tools and metrics to assess the effectiveness and impact of the project on both participants and your organization.

9. What are the milestones for Employers?

 Employer Partner milestones include: Riipen platform onboarding and orientation, Riipen Design/Creation Session, the Challenge Kick-off Meeting, optional check-ins with learners throughout the project, learners' final presentation, and providing feedback through the Riipen portal. For a complete timeline and detailed requirements, please refer to the Challenge Template document. Additional milestones may be required based on specific project needs.

11. How do I identify the right people at my company to participate?

Look for employee/s who have relevant technical expertise, can dedicate time to key
project milestones (especially the kick-off and final presentations), and are passionate
about mentoring and developing emerging talent. Many projects will benefit from
employee/s who bring diverse perspectives from different departments or roles in the
organization. Early career professionals or recent graduates can serve as relatable peer
mentors for students.
