The Parks Chamber welcomes the Consul General of Canada

On Friday, October 6th, The Parks Chamber welcomed the Consul General of Canada, Aaron Annable to Loves Park City Hall. The event was arranged by Representative John Cabello.

The Consul General represents Canada in Illinois, Missouri and Wisconsin and promotes trade, economic, political and cultural relations with Canada throughout this region. Highlights of the Consul General presentation included:

- Illinois exports \$23.8 billion in goods to Canada annually
- Illinois imports \$68.3 billion in goods from Canada annually
- Illinois District 16 exports \$2.4 billion in goods to Canada annually
- Illinois District 16 exports \$43 million in services to Canada annually
