Throughout his career, Mr. Rowe had been active in programs and organizations aimed at educating the public about the positive contributions of the engineering profession. As founder and CEO of Rowe Engineering and as a Vice President for Inland Seas Engineering, Mr. Rowe successfully completed hundreds of residential, commercial and industrial engineering and surveying projects throughout Michigan.
