Major Goal #1:

Provide a competitive advantage for member firms to drive higher levels of business success.

- ACEC will formulate definitive legislative positions and publicly communicate those positions to influence positive change as the advocate for engineering and related professional service firms with a focus on promoting and protecting the use of Qualifications-Based Selection.
- ACEC will be the pre-eminent resource for obtaining business and management education and training for engineering and related professional service firms while actively promoting our collective expertise on issues affecting the built environment.
- ACEC will use the Engineering & Surveying Excellence Gala and similar activities to share the talents and achievements of ACEC member firms and reinforce the positive impact member firms provide.
- ACEC will keep members informed of the newest technology, government tax and policy changes, and business practices that improve firm management and lower costs.

Major Goal #2:

Grow and diversify membership in the organization and develop strategic partnerships to broaden the platform for resources and engagement.

- ACEC will broaden the membership base, in partnership with ACEC National, by adding firms from new market segments without sacrificing the value currently provided to its member firms.
- ACEC will promote a culturally diverse workforce through public relations, pathways for success, and workforce development of underrepresented population segments in the industry.

- ACEC will seek out opportunities to partner with allied professions and industries as a mechanism to introduce a broader range of firms to ACEC and to expand offerings for member firms.
- ACEC will develop and offer business practice forums to increase value for existing firms and as a recruiting tool for new members.

Major Goal #3:

Support efforts to create a robust pipeline of future engineering talent, to ensure long term sustainability and relevance of the engineering industry.

- ACEC will inventory current programs designed to attract K-12 and college students to a career in engineering and increase the involvement of member firms in these programs.
- ACEC will partner with other engineering societies, such as ASCE, ITE, etc., to align our resources on workforce development initiatives that attract talent to the engineering community.
- ACEC will provide emerging leaders, management and executive level continuing educational and development opportunities for member firms.
