ACEC/Michigan's "Member Firm of the Year" is the only award program instituted to recognize ACEC/Michigan member firms for their demonstrated leadership in promoting engineering through their activities with ACEC and in their communities. Winning this competition will greatly enhance your firm's marketing efforts to both current and potential clients.

Both a small firm (1-40 employees) and a large firm (>40 employees) are eligible to receive this award. The winning firms are announced during the ACEC/Michigan Engineering & Surveying Excellence Awards Gala.

Firms who have won in the last 5 years are not eligible.
