MSN DUAL CREDIT

- Family Nurse Practitioner
- Nursing Education
- Nursing Leadership and Administration
- Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner

Students must have a 3.0 GPA at course registration to qualify to take these courses.

BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING – RN-BSN* ONLINE

The average length of time for a student taking a full course load is 12 months when transferring in an applicable nursing or associate degree.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

To enroll in Herzing's RN-BSN Online program, prospective students must live in a state where Herzing University is authorized to offer the RN-BSN Online program and:

1. Hold a current, active and unrestricted license as a registered nurse (RN) in the same state in which they practice.
2. Hold an associate degree or diploma in nursing from a nationally or regionally accredited college or university.

TRANSFER CREDITS IN NURSING

Up to 70 semester credit hours may be block transferred toward degree completion.
