Population and Income

The local population was 273,280 in 2023, an increase of 1.4% from the previous year. Population has grown 7.3% over the past five years (2019-2023). The local population grew faster than the US average in 2023.





Per capita income in College Station-Bryan was \$51,507, an increase of \$2,869 from the previous year. Per capita income was 74% of the US average in 2023.

Employment

Job Growth

Job growth in this market was 1.94% in June 2024 compared to a year ago. This compares to a national rate of 0.11% during the same time period.



Unemployment

The unemployment rate for College Station-Bryan in December 2024 was 2.7% versus 2.6% a year ago and a national rate of 4.1%.

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Residential Real Estate

Home Price

Home prices in this market averaged \$286,900 in 2023, lower than the US average.



Housing Permits

Total housing permits in December 2024 were -176.5% from last year. Single family permits were up 59.3% and multi-family permits were 200.0%.





Occupied Housing Rates

College Station-Bryan had a total of 109,360 housing units in 2022. Of these, 49% were rental units and 51% were owner-occupied.



Home and Rent Price Forecast

Home and rent prices are critical drivers of a local economy's overall health. Local Market Monitor founder Ingo Winzer has won the prestigious "Crystal Ball Award" three years in a row. In 2020, he placed first in four categories for Outstanding Performance amongst a distinguished panel of over 100 economists, investment strategists, and housing market analysts.

Local Market Monitor's Three-Year Home Price Forecast

Home prices in this market averaged 4% growth in 2023, lower than the US average. Home prices in College Station-Bryan are forecasted to change by 0% in 2025, 2% in 2026 and 4% in 2027.



Local Market Monitor's Three-Year Rent Price Forecast

Gross monthly rent for College Station-Bryan averaged \$1,107 in 2022, lower than the US average. Gross monthly rent is forecasted to decrease to \$- in 2023.
