Quilt Show

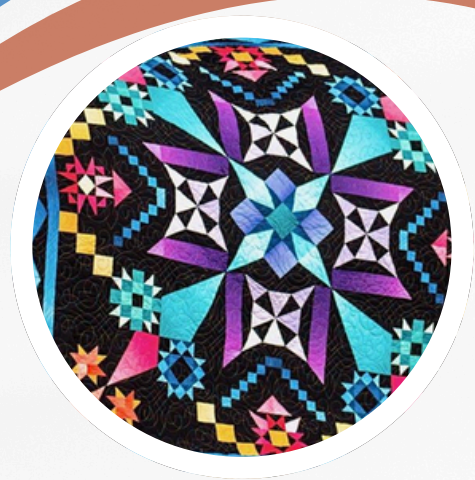

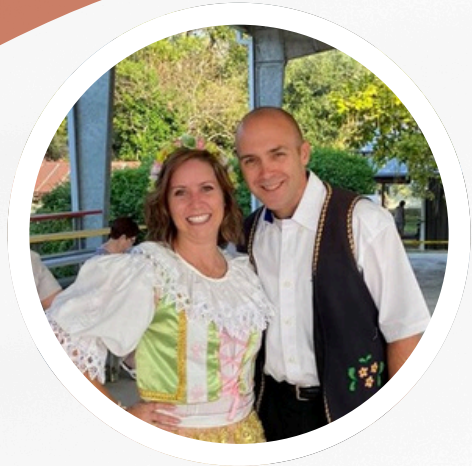
