Honoring the Memory of Dr. Richard G "Wick" Alexander, 1936-2022

Whereas: Dr. Richard G Alexander was a member of the Southwest Component of the Edward H. Angle Society

of Orthodontists; and

Whereas: We have learned with profound regret and sense of loss of his death on Thursday, April 22, 2022, at

age 86; and

Whereas: Wick was born in Lubbock, Texas on February 25th, 1936. He graduated from Amarillo High School

and attended Texas Tech University on a football scholarship. His dental and orthodontic training was

at the University of Texas Houston Dental Branch; and

Whereas: Wick created The Alexander Discipline, and over the course of his career lectured on 6 of the 7

continents, in over 60 countries, to hundreds of professional meetings and symposiums. Alexander Discipline Study Clubs were formed in Japan, Italy, Mexico, Brazil, Germany, and many other countries. Dr. Alexander also taught residents in the Orthodontic Department at Baylor College of Dentistry for over 40 years, he authored numerous books and published many papers. He was an

outstanding clinician, teacher, and researcher; and

Whereas: Wick was also very active in community affairs and organizations, including the Downtown Rotary

Club, Big Brothers, YMCA, Arlington Boys Club, the United Way, as well as every booster club at

Arlington High School; and

Whereas: Wick was preceded in death by his parents, Geraldine and Jenkins Alexander, brother, Dr. Charles

Moody Alexander, and his wife of 62 years, Janna. He is survived by his children, Dr. Chuck Alexander of Montrose, Colorado, Dr. Moody Alexander of Arlington, and Shanna Argote of

Southlake, TX; and
