Honoring the Memory of Dr. Vance Jacob Dykhouse, 1941-2022

- Whereas:** Dr. Vance J. Dykhouse was a member of the Angle Midwest Component of the Edward H. Angle Society of Orthodontists; and
- Whereas:** We have learned with profound regret and sense of loss of his death on September 18, 2022 at age 81; and
- Whereas:** He received undergraduate degree from the University of Oklahoma, his dental degree from the University of Missouri at Kansas City Dental School, and his orthodontic residency master's degree from the University of Missouri at Kansas City. He practiced orthodontics in Kansas City/Blue Springs, Missouri for 43+ years. He was much beloved by his many patients; and
- Whereas:** He served as part time instructor at the orthodontic department at the University of Missouri at Kansas City for 33 years, instructor at the Charles H. Tweed International Foundation for 29 years, served on the Missouri Speciality Board for 21 years, served as president of the American Society of Dentistry for Children, served the Tweed Study Club of the Midwest, and served on the admissions committee of the Midwest Component of the Edward H. Angle Society; and
- Whereas:** He served eight years as the Midwest Director to the American Board of Orthodontics and president of the American Board of Orthodontics from May 2006 to May 2007. He was honored with the Dale B. Wade Award for Excellence in Orthodontics by the American Board of Orthodontics and the University of Missouri at Kansas City "Distinguished Orthodontist of the Year" award. His impeccable attention to detail brought him much respect from all those he taught and served. He was active in his church congregation holding many offices. He worked with Kiwanis and the Raytown High School Booster Club. First and foremost, he was a gentleman and family man; married to the love of his life, Judy for 57 years; and
- Whereas:** He is survived by his wife, Judith (Puckett) Dykhouse, his daughter, Diane Knapp (husband Robert) – granddaughter, Morgan Hobbs (husband Conner) - great grandchildren, Hudson, Allison and Nicole – his son, David (wife Marsha), and grandchildren, Sydney, Ryan and Logan; and
