



NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

ARTICLE X - MEETINGS AND QUORUMS *(add highlighted words)*

Section 6.

Whenever, in the judgment of the Board of Directors, any question shall arise which it believes should be put to a vote of the membership and when it deems it inexpedient to call a special meeting for such purpose, the Board of Directors may, unless otherwise required by these By-Laws, submit such a matter to the Members, in writing by mail **or by electronic message** for vote and decision, and the question shall be determined according to a majority vote of the votes received by mail, facsimile transmission, electronic or telegraph within thirty (30) days after submission of the issue to the members, provided that, in each case, the votes of at least ten percent (10%) of the voting members shall have been received. Any and all actions taken pursuant to a majority vote in each case shall be binding upon the Chapter in the same manner as would be action taken at a duty called meeting.

ARTICLE XVI - AMENDMENTS *(strike highlighted word)*

Section 1.

Upon proposal by the Board of Directors, these By-Laws may be amended, repealed, or altered, in whole or in part, (a) by a majority vote of the Members present at any meeting of the Chapter, provided that a copy of any amendment proposed for consideration shall be mailed to the last recorded address of the Delegate of each Member of the Chapter at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of the meeting, or (b) by approval of the Delegates of the Members through **mail** vote in accordance with the provisions of Article X, Section 6.
